RE: CANCELLATION OF TIT

Reference is made to your letter ref. ED/KCCA/006/03 dated 21st March, 2018 on the above subject.

Cabinet at its meeting of 7th June, 2017 vide Minute (CT2017) approved the road map for cancellation of titles in wetlands on public land. The list of Plot Nos with titles in wetlands for cancellation and for vanquishing and for specific action is attached below. This should guide your actions.


